



Nicole Marie Spink Driver Safety Scholarship

Description:

Established in 2005 to honor the memory of Nicole Marie Spink, age 19, who was tragically killed in an automobile accident, the recipient of this scholarship will learn safe driving skills.

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide one Oswego County junior or senior with a complete course in driver education safety.

Criteria:

- ✚ Must be at least 16 years of age.
- ✚ Must be an Oswego County high school junior or senior.
- ✚ Must be recommended by a guidance counselor.
- ✚ Applicant must complete an essay on why driver education training is important. This essay must be about their personal experience and not a research essay.
- ✚ Must complete an Oswego County BOCES-sponsored 5 or 6-hour driving program.
- ✚ Licensed students with moving violations will be considered.
- ✚ Ability to pay will be considered.
- ✚ All criteria being equal a Pulaski student will be given preference.
- ✚ Students must have their own transportation to the defensive driving program site.
- ✚ Guidance Counselor recommendations and personal essays must accompany applications to be considered.
- ✚ Must have a N.Y.S. Motor Vehicle Department's Learner Permit to apply for the 5-hour Prelicensing Driving Course. The 6-hour Defensive Driving course is for students who have their driving license.
- ✚ The Driver Safety Scholarship recipient is responsible for registering for the 5-hour Prelicensing or the 6-hour driving course. <http://www.oswegoboces.org/adulted/driving>

Selection:

The Selection Committee will be flexible and may consist of Laura Yard and/or her designee(s), a BOCES representative, and a high school counselor. Changes may occur in the committee to meet the needs of the drivers' education program and the family. Recommendations and essays will be reviewed to select a recipient.

Deadline:

Applications must include a guidance counselor recommendation letter and an applicant essay. For the spring scholarship, applications must be postmarked by the last Monday in March, in order to attend the April or May 5-hour or 6-hour driving program. For the fall scholarship, applications must be postmarked by the last Friday in August, in order to attend the October or November 5-hour or 6-hour driving program.
